Concept Note: The proposed two-day's workshop on research methodology is meant for those candidates who have applied for research grant (2021-22) from M&EA trust. On the first day (27th January) of the workshop, the experts will introduce basics of research methodology covering important topics namely, critical review of literature, research design, sampling design, methods of data collection, analysis of data, research ethics and writing the report, to the participants. Based on the learnings from these lectures, the candidates are required to revise their proposals and on the second day (28th January), they have to present their revised proposal to the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) of M&EA Trust. The Committee will select the final list of proposals for funding, and communicate the decision to the grantees later.
