

Vacancy Announcement: RA- Data Analyst / Data Manager

Madras Institute of Development Studies, Chennai is looking to hire a **Statistical Data Analyst / Data Manager** for the **Tamil Nadu Household Panel Survey (2024-25)**. This project is being implemented in collaboration with Department of Economics and Statistics, Govt. of Tamil Nadu. The job description is given below.

The Statistical data analyst/ manager will interpret quantitative data and design statistical models for researching questions under the Tamil Nadu Household Panel Survey (TNHPS).

They will hold the primary responsibility for –

1. Documenting the data management process and reporting the same to the research manager on a daily basis.
2. Organizing, cleaning and preparing data for analysis.
3. To assist in report writing.
4. To assist in data analysis, and preparation of documents and presentations for dissemination, in consultation with the rest of the team.
5. Working with the Principal Investigators in carrying out in-depth data analysis/ econometric analysis.
6. In addition, you are required to:
 - a. Manage time and resources, work independently, and pay attention to details
 - b. Communicate clearly, work in a collaborative environment, and learn and apply new skills in the context.

Desired Qualifications

1. Master's (Data Analyst) / Ph.D. (Data Manager) degree in statistics or econometrics or economics with specialisation in econometrics.
2. Statistical Analysts should be proficient with STATA and R capable of performing complex statistical analysis using STATA, R and other statistical software is a must.
3. Experience with statistical analysis (e.g., ANOVA and regression, survey sampling) and developing summary/analytical reports is a plus.
4. Experience with creating and supporting complex reports using SSRS and/or Tableau. Experience with Business Intelligence and ETL tools is a plus.
5. Experience that demonstrates team working skills and coordination of technical development initiatives. Effective verbal and written communications skills.
6. Experience with complex survey and process data using various modes of data collection (e.g., paper, computer-assisted, web) and knowledge about the related data challenges/issues. Requires a broad understanding of all areas of survey research
7. Candidate must have a minimum of 1 year work experience in the relevant area.

Duration- The duration will be initially for one year 2024-25, with the possibility of an extension.
