The MIDS Library with its vast collection of knowledge resources provides important services to the research scholars and faculty in the institute and, where possible, to the general public in their intellectual pursuits. The Library subscribes, on a consortium basis, to various e-databases namely Indiastat, Prowess IQ, and a wealth of e-resources via ICSSR's NASSDOC, while also providing access to the popular JStor, Econlit databases to enrich the knowledge base of faculty and research scholars. In addition, the Library subscribes to the databases of CMIE's Economic Outlook and EPWRFIT series. The databases of Census of India, NSSO, ASI, etc. are also available in print format in the library. A specialty of the library is the extensive collection of government publications and statistical reports, dating to the late 19th Century. The advantages of using e-databases are manifold as these electronic resources are accessible on the campus network, therefore, facilitating these e-databases and making them centrally available to the research scholars.

The Library intends to conduct periodical training programmes for the scholars as it helps to understand the modern research requirements and be more aware of the demands of the scholars from different backgrounds. In this context, the MIDS Library organizes a one-day intensive workshop on Effective Usage of E-Resources available in the library on 10 July 2024.
